Merlot shows extraordinarily well in this delicate vintage, contributing a palate-enveloping sweetness and finesse. Deeply colored with light woody notes, a juicy attack and very ripe tannins: this is a classic, aromatic, enormously charming Saint-Emilion. Olive and grape aromas stand out, with a finish showing a nutty character of almonds and hazelnuts accompanied by great freshness and a savory touch. This wine will be ready to drink very soon; be sure to decant it shortly before serving. It will perfectly accompany meats both hot and cold.
